Poverty and Policy in Canada: Its Impact on the Health of Marginalized Populations

Guest Speaker: Dr. Dennis Raphael

Professor of Health Policy and Management, York University

Dr. Raphael's most recent scientific publications have focused on the health effects of income inequality and poverty, the quality of life of communities and individuals, and the impact of government decisions on Canadians' health and well-being. Dr. Raphael is editor of "Social Determinants of Health: Canadian Perspectives" and "Health Promotion and Quality of Life in Canada: Essential Readings" and co-editor of "Staying Alive: Critical Perspectives on Health, Illness, and Health Care." Dr. Raphael has also written "Poverty and Policy in Canada: Implications for Health and Quality of Life" and "About Canada: Health and Illness". With Juha Mikkonen, he produced a primer on the social determinants of health entitled "Social Determinants of Health: The Canadian Facts" which has been downloaded 30,000 times from <http://thecanadianfacts.org>
